**Event Description: Infection Prevention and Risk Management in the 21st Century: Dental Best Practices for Disinfection and Sterilization of Patient Care Items Using Current Sterilizer Monitoring Guidelines.**

Kay will address the discrepancies between sterilization procedures in most dental practices and the current guidelines used by hospitals to prevent patient-to-patient transmission of infectious disease and will demonstrate how to meet the new standards.

- Define the categories of patient-care items based on risk of infection involved in their use.
- Identify the bloodborne disease that is easiest to transmit by poor infection control practices.
- Narrow the gap between monitoring sterilizers and obtaining results, reducing the risk of releasing non-sterile instruments for patient care.

Kay is an Infection Preventionist who limits her practice to the dental field. She is Board Certified in Infection Control and Epidemiology.

She is active in her medically-focused infection prevention association, Association for Professionals in Infection Control and Epidemiology (APIC), a national organization of over 13,000 members and served as an officer for APIC for four years. In addition, she served twice as president of the Arizona State APIC chapter. She has used these resources as a foundation to build dental infection control best practices.

She is a member of OSAP, the national dental infection control association, and presently a member of the Core Competencies working group forming a Body of Knowledge for OSAP.

She has been the editor of all three editions of the Dental Services Chapter written by Drs. John Molinari and Jennifer Harte for the APIC Text of Infection Control and Epidemiology in addition to working with The Arizona Dental Association to provide continuing education for their members.

Widely published and a seasoned speaker for national and local audiences, she consults for the dental community with an emphasis on best practices for Infection Prevention, OSHA and risk management.

**Event Description: 3D Digital Radiography in Dentistry Today  
1:30pm-4:30pm (3 CEUs)**

**SPEAKER:** Dr. Donald Tyndall, DDS, MSPH, PhD, FICD, Dip ABOMR

This 3 hour course will take the practitioner into the third dimension. After attending, the practitioner will leave with a clear understanding of what CBCT is, how it differs from traditional 2D radiography, what the legal and ethical responsibilities for reviewing CBCT volumes are, as well as how to go over a CBCT scan. It will also include software demonstrations and example cases of many different clinical applications including: implants, developmental abnormalities, periodontal disease, endodontic problems, orthodontics, pathology, oral surgery and sleep apnea. There will be a question and answer session following the presentation.

Dr. Don Tyndall is Professor in the Department of Diagnostic Sciences and General Dentistry at the UNC School of Dentistry. He received his D.D.S. in 1980 from the UNC School of Dentistry, his M.S.P.H. in Radiological Hygiene and Medical Physics from the UNC School of Public Health in 1984, and his Ph.D. in Health Physics and Radiation Biology from UNC in 1988.

He has won several awards for teaching excellence at UNC. Dr. Tyndall has been the Director of Radiology for the School of Dentistry from 1988 to the present and serves as the course director for two pre-doctoral radiology courses. Dr. Tyndall has also served as a Commissioner on the North Carolina Radiation Protection Commission from 1988 to 2005 and as Program Director of the Oral and Maxillofacial Radiology Graduate Program at the School of Dentistry from 1993 to 2006. He is a Diplomate of the American Board of Oral and Maxillofacial Radiology and was a Director and past President of the American Board of Oral and Maxillofacial Radiology. Dr. Tyndall is currently the Councillor for Scientific Affairs and Public Policy of the Executive Council of the American Academy of Oral and Maxillofacial Radiology.

Dr. Tyndall holds memberships in such organizations as the American Dental Association, the American Academy of Oral and Maxillofacial Radiology, The International Association of Dentomaxillofacial Radiology and the International Association for Dental Research. His research interests include: 3-D digital imaging, implant radiology, applications of cone beam computed tomography in dentistry and the use of computers in image processing. His work has been published in more than 85 journal articles.
